Rolla Earl Beck, III. "Reb" to his friends, passed away peacefully and surrounded by family on March 6th, 2021. Reb was born in Birmingham, Ala., on October 19, 1947, to Rolla Earl Beck, Jr., and Sarah Alice Wright Beck. Reb graduated Shades Valley High School in 1965. In 1969 he graduated from the University of Alabama with a business degree and was a member of the Sigma Chi fraternity and the ROTC program. He received a juris doctorate from The University in 1972. Mr. Beck discovered manufacturing and sales to be preferable to law and went to work for his father at Beck Sales shortly after passing the Alabama bar. In 1986, Reb founded Utility Specialists, Inc., from his kitchen table and employed dozens of people over the next 35 years. When not closing deals, Reb could often be found on his boat alongside his beautiful wife, Diane, married in 1999. Many a memorable trip began from the dock of the Lake Guntersville Yacht Club. Diane survives him along with his children, Daniel (Lyndall) Beck, Laura Beck (Jeremy) Carlson and Matthew (Darlene) Beck; his sister Sarah Beck (Gary) Grace; brother Murray (Diane) Beck; and grandchildren Ann Wright and Alice Carlson; and Boyd and William Beck. Reb's infectious laughter and spirited love of Alabama football endeared him to many. He loved live music and was a member of the Magic City Blues Society. Reb loved being of service to others; he volunteered for the Red Cross and was a deacon and an elder at Independent Presbyterian Church. He wished to thank his team of dedicated caregivers, who were by his side in his final weeks. A family man of deep faith with an ever present smile, he will be remembered as a great father, cheerful Poppy to his grandchildren, devout Christian and social butterfly who showed his love through generosity. inside the church. You must be registered prior to arrival. If you plan to attend please sign up at this link:


