



HUGH QUINTON GIBBS III, October 20, 1946 - January 5, 2018, passed away at home in Los Angeles, California on January 5th, 2018. A forty year resident of Southern California, he was a physician's assistant who served as the long-time director of Occupational Health Care at the University of California at Los Angeles and spent much of his retirement in pain management consulting. Hugh graduated from Shades Valley High School and University of Alabama Birmingham.

In his last year, Hugh was in the care of the head of the liver unit at UCLA. His passing was sudden and unexpected, finally succumbing to liver disease. He was well until the last months of his life.
